Gedalyah Engel Education Award 2023

GRANT OPPORTUNITY

The Engel Award provides up to \$2000 to support educators to educate and inspire their students to recognize discrimination, to stand up for minority groups and other vulnerable populations, and to speak out against manifestations of present-day hatred and prejudice.

Flexible: Any grade level, any discipline, classroom based or extra-curricular.

Meaningful: Projects may be related to Holocaust or genocide education or more broadly to combatting prejudice and discrimination in all its forms, including bullying and human rights.

Local: Applicants must be actively teaching in schools in Indiana ASP District 4: Benton, Warren, Fountain, Montgomery, Tippecanoe, White, Carroll, Cass, and Clinton counties.

Effective: Proposals must have clearly outlined activities and specific student outcomes.

Make your idea into reality! Funds may be used for any of these types of activities:

A. Teacher Learning

Examples: an online or on campus course in Jewish Studies or Holocaust education, travel to learn about the Holocaust, a personal professional development experience focused on combatting prejudice in schools

B. Classroom Projects

Examples: book collections for a specific unit, a student-produced collection of oral histories, purchasing access to video or other resources for research

C. School-wide Projects

Examples: a school visit by an outside speaker, an interdisciplinary event focused on tolerance and inclusion, professional development on building an inclusive school community

D. Student Travel

Examples: a field trip to a Holocaust museum as part of a unit on the Holocaust, culminating student activity such as visits to multiple religious community centers

E. Education Outreach

Examples: a service learning project with local agencies supporting refugees, connecting with community organizations that support human rights

Easy Application:

- 1. Cover Sheet with identifying information
- 2. Proposal: 2 pages including summary, description, budget, and timeline
- 3. Letter of Recommendation from educational leader or colleague
